



Document Checklist—Bring these with you for your Citizenship day appointment:

- Permanent resident card “Green Card”
If you have lost your green card bring a copy and receipt of your form I-90.
- 2 identical color passport photos with your Alien registration number (A-number) written lightly in pencil on the back of the photos.
- Marriage Certificate(s) (current and past marriages)
- Divorce decree(s)/certificate(s) or annulment(s)—
any document relating to the end of a relationship.
- Court documents with any aliases used in the past.
- All passports (current and past).
- Any document relating to a criminal offense in the U.S.
- For payment:
A check or money order for \$725 made out to the *Department of Homeland Security*.
If you would like to pay using a credit card, please bring the card you would like to use.
- Completed N-400 Pre-Worksheet (included here)

If you are applying through marriage with a citizen (3 years):

- A. Your spouse’s birth certificate **or**
Certificate of naturalization **or**
Certificate of citizenship **or**
Your spouse’s U.S. passport and social security card
- B.
 - Tax return from the last three (3) years
 - Bank accounts
 - Leases
 - Mortgages
 - Children’s birth certificates and social security cards
