Free Film Screening and Discussion of Refugee and Immigration Issues

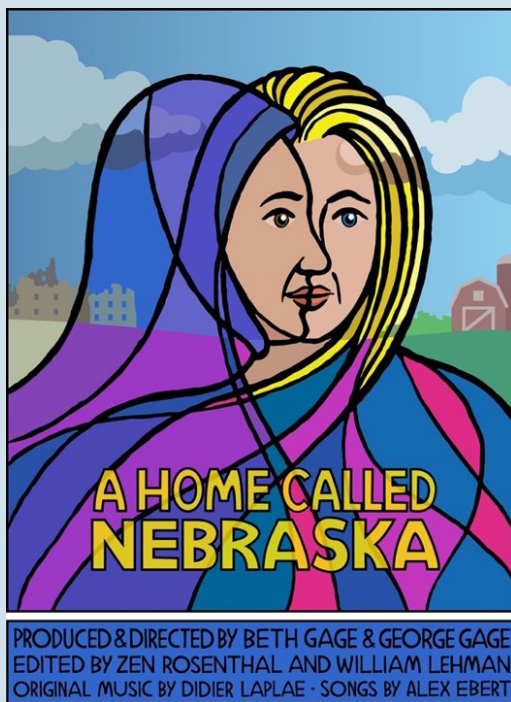
